What Impacts Sustainable Agriculture & Biodiversity?

- Climate change is a major threat to bio-diversity.
- Modern industrial agriculture can have extremely negative impacts on biodiversity.
- Often a crop is genetically engineered to withstand high-levels of herbicides or other poisons that are designed to kill weeds or animal pests.
- Unfortunately, the pesticides routinely applied to these crops also kill many other plants and animals, including many non-target species. Thus negatively impacting biodiversity & human health.






Healthcare in Africa - a vicious circle

- Most African health care systems are stuck in a vicious circle of low demand and low supply
- Access to quality basic health care among the poor is also low

PharmAccess Foundation Nigeria

- Was established in 2007.
- In partnership with the Kwara State Government established a Health Insurance Scheme for the Farmers in Shonga in 2007.
- This scheme has transformed to a state wide community based health insurance program for rural dwellers with over 60,000 lives having access to care.



SafeCare In Nigeria

- √The SafeCare standards have been used to assess over 80 facilities.
- ✓ Presently a total of 53 facilities have adopted the SafeCare methodology as their QI strategy.
- ✓ SafeCare has signed an MoU with the NPHCDA to help achieve the objectives of the National Quality Initiative.
- ✓ We have concluded talks with the Ogun State government on institutionalizing Quality Standards state-wide.
